



Wood Floor Care

Here are some guidelines that will help preserve a beautiful finish and keep maintenance to a minimum:

1. Place mats and throw rugs at doorway exteriors and interiors to help prevent the tracking of grit, dirt and sand.
2. Sweep or vacuum wood floors regularly.
3. Most polyurethane finishes allow for damp mopping, (with a well wrung mop) for periodic cleaning of dirt buildup. Standing water can dull the finish, damage the wood and leave a discoloring residue. PLEASE FOLLOW FINISH MANUFACTURERS INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING.
4. Wipe up food and other spills immediately with a dry or slightly dampened towel (wipe dry).
5. Put felt-faced glides under the legs of furniture to prevent scuffing and scratching.
6. Remember: cleats, sports shoes and high heels can dent any floor surface.
7. When moving heavy furniture, protect wood flooring by slipping a piece of cloth or pile under the legs or covering each leg with a heavy sock or half a milk carton.
